2:30pm Vespers with the veneration of the Holy Shroud -- After Vespers there will be a snack offered in the downstairs hall to break the strict fast.

5:00pm (after the snack) Matins with Lamentations and Burial Rite.

12:00 Midnight Paschal Matins and Paschal Liturgy

Full blessing of Kulich before the meal - after Paschal Liturgy.

Breaking the Fast: The Sisterhood invites all to break the fast together in the parish hall following the Paschal Divine Liturgy (early in the morn. on April 28). Everyone is asked to bring a ready dish to pass. Please bring dishes that **do not** need to be warmed up.
